Most of you are at least somewhat familiar with the long-running PBS children's show, "Mr. Rogers' Neighborhood." The show, which originally aired from 1968 until 2001, reached millions of children as it addressed early childhood themes. Of course, younger generations may be more familiar with "Daniel Tiger's Neighborhood," which was a animated spin-off of based on characters in the original show.

What you might not know is that the host of "Mr. Rogers' Neighborhood," Fred Rogers, was also an ordained Presbyterian pastor. While the show never claimed to be religious, and Mr. Rogers didn't typically quote scripture in the show, he was able to share with generations of children what it means to live as Christ would have us to live – together in community – and how to love ourselves and to love one another.

In a few weeks, we will kick off our Fall worship series, "Won't You Be My Neighbor?" named for the song that Mr. Rogers sang at the beginning of each show. We will use the lens of Mr. Rogers, combined with Scripture, to look at how we are called to live in community and to love our neighbors in the name of Christ. Even if you aren't that familiar with Mr. Rogers, you can you can still appreciate the lessons that he taught...similar lessons to those that Jesus taught. Please plan to join us!
